Naval Academy; as a consequence, the subject has been treated with particular reference to the requirements of the course at that institution. The limitation thus placed has prevented the detailed description of certain features occasionally involved in surveying operations of the most precise nature, as, for example, astronomical transit observations; but all branches of the work connected with a marine hydrographic survey as ordinarily carried out have been completely described, and the book is therefore available for purposes of reference for naval officers and others that may be engaged in such work. In the preparation of the book, existing works on the subject were freely consulted, especially Phelps Practical Marine Surveying, Wharton s Hydrographical Surveying, Bowditch s American Practical Navigator (revised edition), and Gurley s Manual of Surveying Instruments; and much valuable assistance was received from Mr. G. W. Littlehales, Hydrographic Engineer, of the Hydrographic Office...



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
